

- Sending out failed RAS pump to be rebuilt this month
- Working on preparing data for NYSDEC annual flow certification report
- Reviewing sanitary sewer collection system as-builts to find target areas for inflow and infiltration
- Documenting illicit connections of sump pumps and gutters when repairing water meters
- Met with Steve Grimm from NYRWA about a grease inceptor for a sewer user that is causing grease problems at plant, also discussed different approaches to identifying I&I problems
- Pulled loaner pump from LaPlante and installed rebuilt pump at Boat Club
